

Reopening Guidelines for Rise and Climb Adventure Course Operations During the Covid-19 Pandemic

These policies are in accordance with the guidelines set by the Chief Public Health Office and will be enforced until further notice. Updated 6/29/2020

All visitors must stay home if they are feeling ill or experiencing any cold or flu like symptoms.
All visitors must not have been outside of PEI within the last 14 days and are not required to self-isolate.

COURSE CAPACITY

We are now able to accommodate up to 50 climbers on the course. We continue to have specific training times to manage the flow of participants. To maintain social distancing, only one person will be allowed per platform. The Zip Lines will remain closed for the season.

Online booking is highly recommended.

CLEANING

Gear and equipment will be cleaned after use. Hand sanitizer is available around the premises.

STAFF

Staff may wear a face mask during gear check, while operating belay devices and during rescues.

Staff will be asked to stay home if they are feeling ill or experiencing any cold or flu like symptoms.

LASER TAG

Players must maintain physical distancing of 6 ft with individuals who are not part of one's household. Laser tag guns will be wiped down and disinfected after each use.

Booking must be made in advance.

WAIVERS

Participants are encouraged to have a completed waiver and attestation prior to climbing. These may be printed at home to limit contact at the course. They can be found at the following links:
